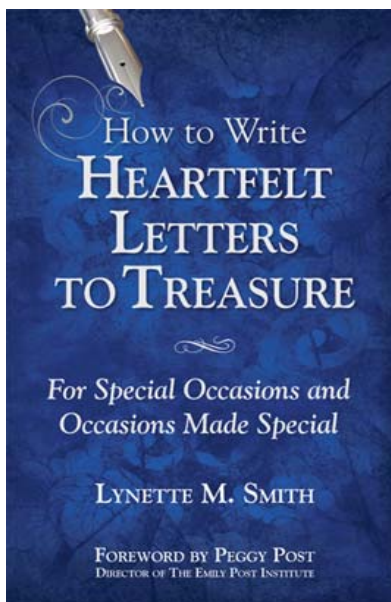


Lynette Smith is a professional copyeditor who enjoys helping people get the results and respect their writing deserves.

In 2007, she launched her website, AllMyBest.com, which not only promotes her copyediting service but also offers free writing advice—grammar tips she wrote in plain English, a computer-terms spelling dictionary she compiled, and the best writing-related links she’s been able to find.

In October 2009, Lynette introduced her publishing website, GoodWaysToWrite.com, to distribute her line of information products. Inspired by the framed letter of appreciation her son presented to his parents when he married, she started with a line of four marriage-themed tips booklets, **GOOD WAYS TO WRITE A TREASURED LETTER**, to help brides, grooms, and their parents compose and present letters of appreciation to one another. Then, in August 2012, she published the comprehensive reference book, **HOW TO WRITE HEARTFELT LETTERS TO TREASURE: FOR SPECIAL OCCASIONS AND OCCASIONS MADE SPECIAL**, releasing the eBook version just three months later.



Many more appreciation-themed projects are being developed, all in support of what has become Lynette’s **BIG, ACHIEVABLE GOAL: to get millions of people worldwide to write heartfelt letters of appreciation so they can establish, enhance, and even rebuild their relationships and thus change their world.**
